Customization

Upon registering, a user will be asked to select their swim league and team from a pull down menu. This allows **StrokeandTurn.com** the ability to present custom content to users coming to the site from your league. As an example, the course certificate can be customized to present your swim league or team's logo. It also allows the ability to display up to three additional graphics on the course home page. These three spaces can be used as ad space allowing you to potentially generate revenue by offering local businesses the opportunity to display their logo on the site. Alternatively, these ads can be offered to individuals to display a custom graphic wishing a loved one good luck as an example.
